- 1) Completed and Certified NRA Basic Pistol Course or equivalent
- 2) Pre-course Questionnaire
- 3) Pre-course Assessment (must pass with grade 80% or higher).
- 4) Be able to demonstrate loading and unloading a pistol and revolver

What to Bring: A safe attitude; Your Pistol, either revolver or semi-auto pistol; eye and ear protection, ammunition, approximately **two hundred rounds per person**. Two magazines for your self-loading (semi-auto) pistol or speed loaders for your revolver. Snap caps for your pistol. Bring your drivers license and Social Security number Lunch/snacks and drinks.

What I will provide: Included in the course tuition at no additional cost (\$75.00) is the NRA Handbook; writing materials; various learning and training aids; multiple handouts; enthusiasm; a safe learning environment. NRA "Personal Protection in the Home" certificate and Tennessee or Virginia Carry Application form or completion certificate.

DIRECTIONS TO CHEROKEE ROD AND GUN CLUB

From Va. Proceeding South and West on I-81:

Turn North onto I81/I-26 (was I-181) exit 57B “Kingsport”

Proceed north on I-26 (was I-181) approx 5 miles to I-26 Exit 3 (was I-181 exit 52) “Meadowview/Bays Mountain/Planetarium”

At the bottom of the exit ramp (Meadowview Convention Center will be on your right) turn left onto Meadowview Parkway/Reservoir Road (you will pass under I-26 going west) away from the convention center.

Stay left at the first “Y” and the road name will change from Meadowview Parkway to Reservoir Road. See below for common path/directions to club.

From Va. South on I-26:

Proceeding south on I-26 over Bays Mountain to I-26 Exit 3 (was I-181 Exit 52) “Meadowview/Bays Mountain/Planetarium”

At the bottom of the exit ramp (Meadowview Convention Center will be across the interstate on your left) turn right onto Meadowview Parkway/Reservoir Road (you will NOT pass under I-26 going west) away from the convention center.

Stay left at the first “Y” and the road name will change from Meadowview Parkway to Reservoir Road. See below for common path/directions to club.

From TN going north from Johnson City on I-26:

From the I81/I-26 interchange continue toward Kingsport north on I-26 approx 5 miles to I-26 Exit 3 “Meadowview/Bays Mountain/Planetarium”

At the bottom of the exit ramp (Meadowview Convention Center will be on your right) turn left onto Meadowview Parkway/Reservoir Road (you will pass under I-26 going west) away from the convention center.

Stay left at the first “Y” and the road name will change from Meadowview Parkway to Reservoir Road. See below for common path/directions to club.

From TN going North and East from Knoxville on I-81:

Turn North onto I81/I-26 exit 57B “Kingsport”

Proceed North on I-26 approx 5 miles to I-26 Exit 3 “Meadowview/Bays Mountain/Planetarium”

At the bottom of the exit ramp (Meadowview Convention Center will be on your right) turn left onto Meadowview Parkway/Reservoir Road (you will pass under I-26 going west) away from the convention center.

Stay left at the first “Y” and the road name will change from Meadowview Parkway to Reservoir Road. See below for common path/directions to club.

Common Directions from I-26 Exit 3 continued from above:

Proceed west on Reservoir Road approximately 5.6 miles.

You will pass the following landmarks:

- 1) Willowbrook Condo Entrance at approx 0.7 miles from I-26 Exit 3 on your right
- 2) ~~Children's Petting zoo, Mirth Haven Farm, on your left (keep right at the next "Y")~~ closed
- 3) Depew's Chapel Methodist Church on your right and church cemetery on your left (take it easy into this curve it is sharp and slippery when wet)
- 4) Bays Mountain Park Cutoff/Intersection (this is just a tee, you keep going straight, you are now approximately 2.5 miles from the club entrance) You have gone approximately 2.3 miles from the interstate exit, 3 at this point.
- 5) The club entrance will be on your right and there is a large sign at the entrance. Note that there are no stop signs between exit 52 and the club entrance on Reservoir Road. There is a stop sign about 300 yards beyond the club entrance so if you come to a stop sign you have overshot the club entrance a little bit. Just turn around and come back a few hundred yards.
- 6) Once you turn into the club entrance the pond and caretakers house will be on your left and the main gate will be straight ahead. The main gate will be locked open for you. Proceed through the gate, keeping left at the first "Y".
- 7) Proceed approximately 200 yards keeping right at the next "Y" and continue another 100 yards keeping left at the next "Y" and you will dead end in front of the club house.
- 8) Park as appropriate and enter the middle door and the interior door to the main meeting room.
